At the age of seventeen, Paco began to get involved in the youth ministry at his church. After serving as a leader for six years and finishing his university studies in architecture, God called him to study at the Word of Life Bible Institute in Argentina. In 2004, God put a desire in Paco’s heart, together with Israel Contreras, to start Fusion Ministries, a church-planting ministry established in the state of Queretaro in central Mexico. After planting their first church, Iglesia Bíblica Misionera (Bible Missionary Church) in Queretaro, three other churches have been planted around Mexico. Paco and his wife, Shawna, have two children. Pray for Paco and his ministry through Hispanics for Christ.
