## Summary Report of the Southwestern Association Annual Meeting from Pastor Jeff:

The Association Moderator, Pastor Dave Martin of Highland Baptist Church in Junction City, led in the meetings. The SWA 2020-2021 Ballot of Officers and Budget were presented and approved by the in-person and online delegates. The position of SWA Secretary has not been filled and will be filled by the Executive Committee as soon as possible. Pastor Brad Seifert was welcomed as the new Regional Minister. Pastor Brad shared the message during the worship service, stressing the need for the local church to remain focused on the Gospel of Jesus Christ and His example described in Philippians, Chapter 2.

Reports and updates were shared from Dave Martin regarding his deployment to Kuwait as a U.S. Army Chaplain and Pastor Brian Thompson regarding the building process of Purpose Church in Firestone, CO. Much of the material has been purchased and delivered, and the groundbreaking was May 31, 2020. Pastor Brian asked for prayer to finalize the needed building permits to continue with the project. Andy and Sara Wesner of the First Baptist Church in Ellinwood shared God's call on their lives to plant a church. They have spent the last year investigating and learning about this call of starting a church, and are continuing in this direction. Andy continues to pursue a degree from Sioux Falls Seminary. They asked for continued prayer, including for God's leading on possible locations for a church plant within the SWA or NAB Conference.

The annual meetings concluded with a considerable time of prayer for Pastor Brad, Dan Heringer, the former Regional Minister and current Interim Director of the NAB, and all of the SWA churches and pastors.

The rose in the sanctuary today is to celebrate the arrival of Kolt Glenn Williamson born August 7. Proud parents are Karston and Melitia Williamson.


### Thank You
