Baby Bottles

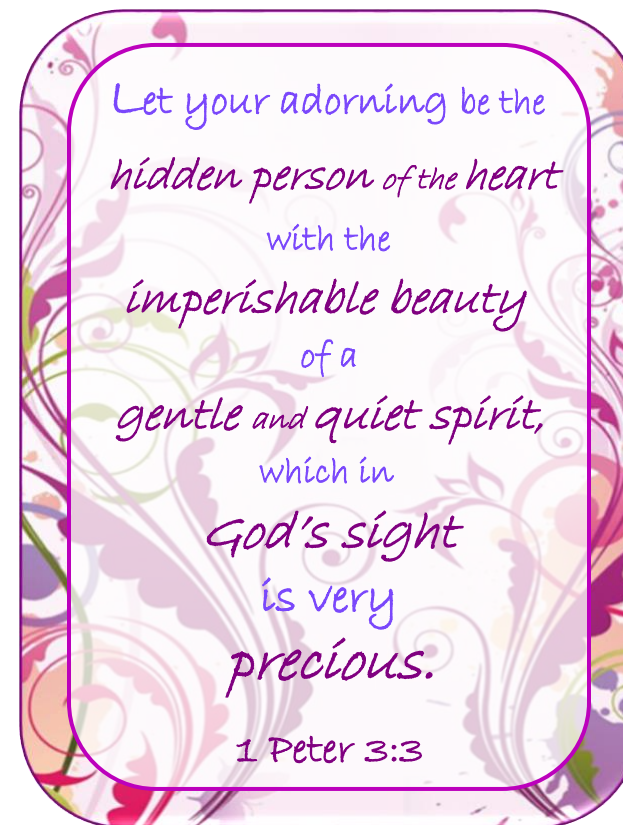
