### Baby Bottle Campaign

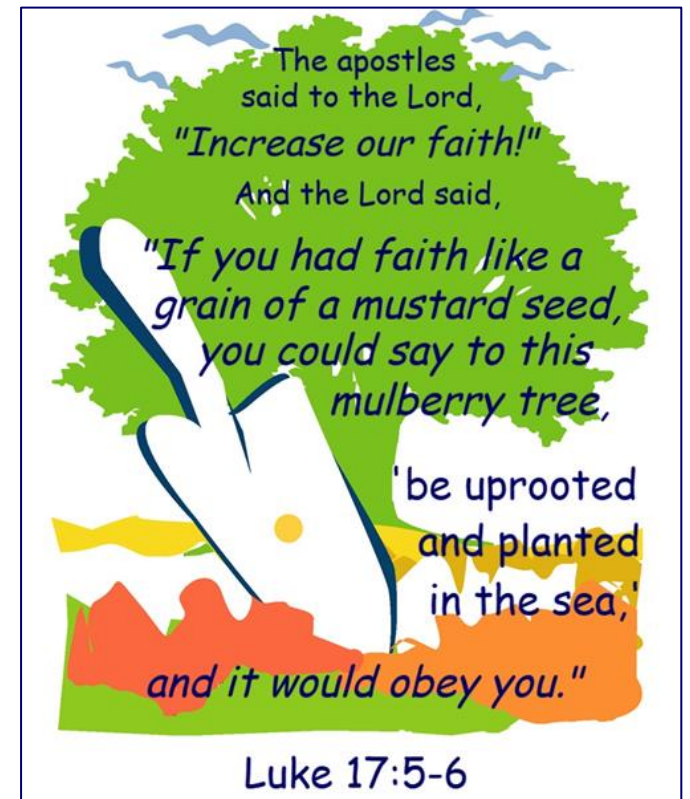
