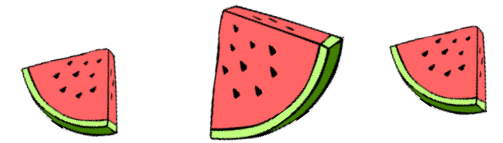

Calvary Baptist Board Meeting

July 13, 2025

Present were Pastor Jeff Lowther, Stan Woodward, Tami Brensing, Don Hildebrand, Jason Hildebrand, Shon Meschberger, Cam Conant, Lee Allen, Jim Huggard, Jake Meyer, and Elizabeth Fitch. Don Hildebrand moderated the meeting in the absence of Marlyn Spare. Don called the meeting to order by asking Joel Vetter to lead in prayer. The minutes of the June 8, 2025, meeting and June 22, 2025 Special Church Meeting were approved as read.

Stan Woodward gave the treasurer’s report. Offerings for June were \$25,664.00. Checking account balance at the end of the month was \$28,434.00 which included \$.67 interest. Stan reported that he had paid the trustee bills for the roof and other expenses. The treasure’s report was approved with a motion by Jim Huggard and Jake Meyer second. Don Hildebrand gave a comparison of income and expenses for the first 6 months of the past and current year.

Committee reports

Deacons: Don Hildebrand reported that vacation time was approved for Pastor Jeff Lowther, July 21-26, to visit his mother and August 8-9, to attend the SWA meeting in Kansas City including expenses.

Don continued by giving an update on the process of the First Baptist Church (FBC) building acquisition. A real estate purchase agreement was signed by Don Hildebrand and Rex Hoskinson of FBC, allowing for a title search back to the plat development. The Underwriter has approved the owner’s policy in the amount of the valuation, with John Hamm giving the opinion on the valuation. The title company will provide the deed, and the State Department of Tax Appeals will be contacted to keep the building off the tax rolls.

The Deacon’s appointed Pastor Isaac and Kailyn Burnett, Shon and Rachel Meschberger, Jabe and Allie Wendelburg as the oversight committee for the youth center, to be known as “The Well” at the newly acquired FBC building. No term limits were given. With a motion by Jake Meyer and a second by Jason Hildebrand a request was approved to grant the committee a \$2,500 expense budget per single event project. A draft of a “Building Resolution” was presented. After discussion, it was agreed that some revisions were needed before final approval could be given. Discussion was held to allow the application for a credit card for the youth pastor for youth activity expenses. With a motion by Jake Meyer and second by Shon Meschberger the request for the application was approved.

CE Board: Joe Vetter reported that Sunday School Promotion will be held August 31 (5th Sunday) with a full Sunday school gathering. There will be no Sunday School held on that day. The church picnic is scheduled for September 7. Jeff Meyer will conclude the Revelation study in the coming weeks and Jason Hildebrand will be facilitating the next adult study on July 21st. Joel reported an adult helper is needed for the Arrows group and the Arrows group will move their opening upstairs into the youth room. Lisa Allen’s position on the CE Board will need to be filled due to her acceptance of the assistant treasurer’s position.

Women’s Ministry: Elizabeth reported that a wedding shower will be held for Morgan Hildebrand Okuyama on Sept 17 while she is in the US.

Trustees: Jake Meyer reported there was a request for a new laptop for the secretary as the desktop computer is becoming outdated. It was granted to purchase the laptop for approximately \$1,000 to allow the secretary to work from home when needed. Jake reported the completion of the new flat roof. He was very pleased with the job and quick timing of the installation.

Jake reported that the church building insurance will need to be renewed by August 31st. Jake presented several scenarios for insurance renewal which included a quote for a “better than nothing” option for the newly gifted building. Don assisted with the explanation of a buy-back deductible option. Don presented a chart with several different options which raised some unanswered questions. By general consent, the board preferred the 80% deductible option, \$7,500 wind and hail deductible, a possible buy-back option for the wind and hail coverage, and the addition of some missing coverage. Due to the lack of information, the discussion was tabled until the next board meeting in August.
