# <u>CBC Special Business Meeting</u> Sunday, June 22, 2025

By a 98% affirmative vote of the CBC members, the bid of \$28,000 was accepted from Webcon, Inc. to repair and replace the roof over the 2012 front area addition of the CBC building. This process was started this week.

By an 87% affirmative vote of the CBC members, CBC will accept the gift from the FBC of Stafford for their building and its contents. Once the transfer is complete with the deed secured, CBC will prepare this building to begin using for the ministry of KidZone, and likely The Well youth group in the fall of 2025.
